

## Rotational Sensitivity

## **Executive Summary**

- Orientation does matter. Many brands of prismatic retroreflective sheeting are rotationally sensitive. If not orientated correctly during sign fabrication and installation, the result will be legends exhibiting inconsistent nighttime appearance, or signs failing to perform to their maximum design potential.
- All of Avery Dennison's retroreflective sheeting are Omni Directional and rotationally insensitive. This engineered feature simplifies sign fabrication and eliminates visual inconsistencies seen in rotationally sensitive materials.
- We strongly encourage the adoption of the orientation specifications described in AASHTO specification M 268, Section 3, to ensure that all traffic signs and devices which depend upon retroreflective sheeting performance meet the intended requirements based on rotational sensitivity.
